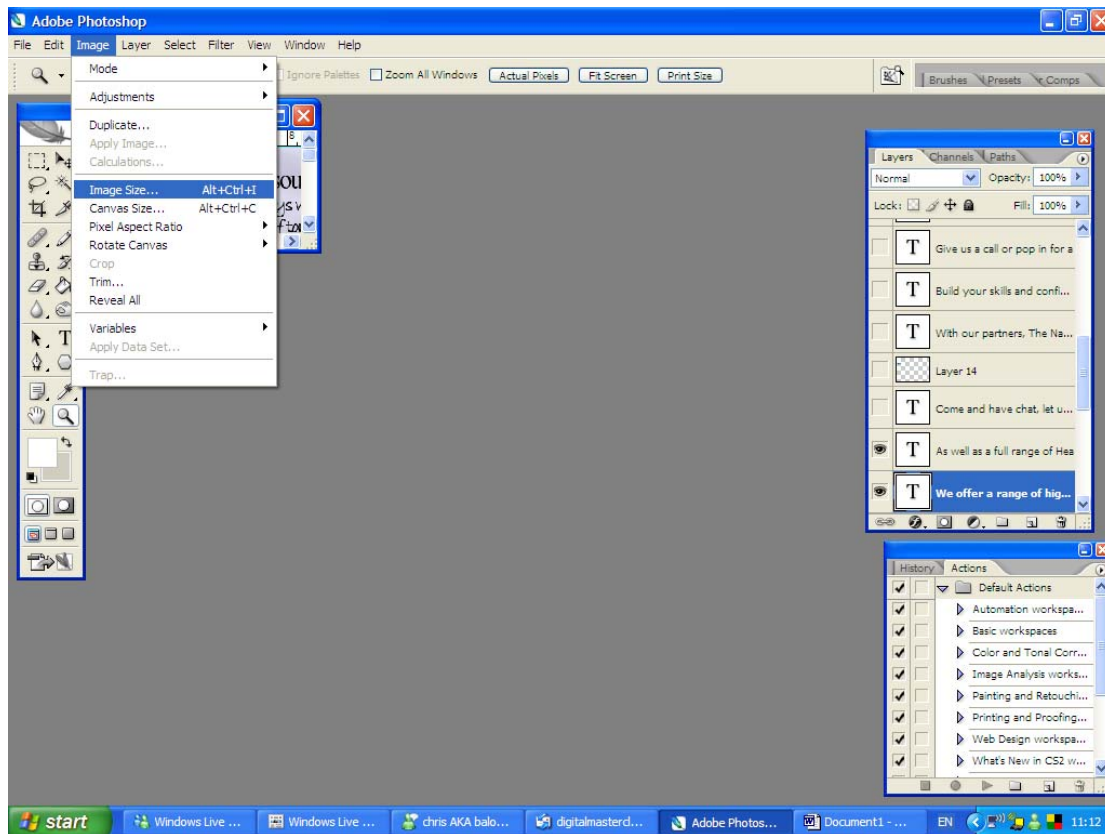
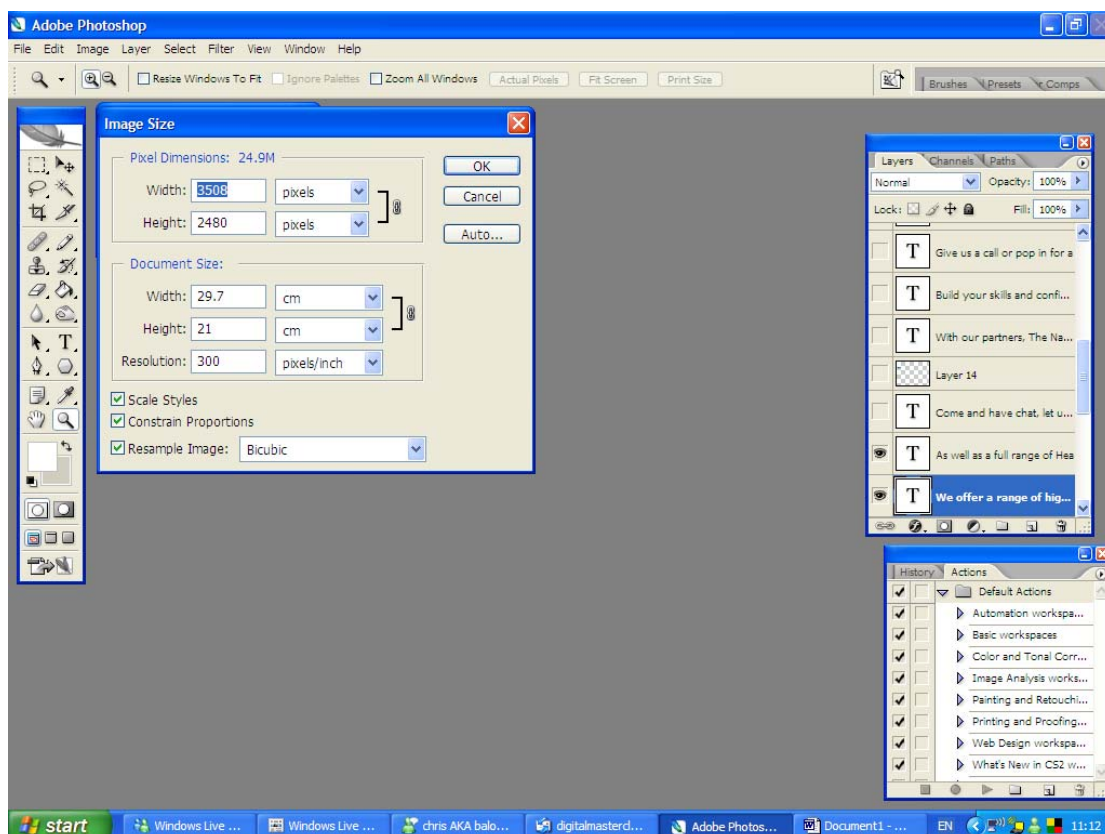


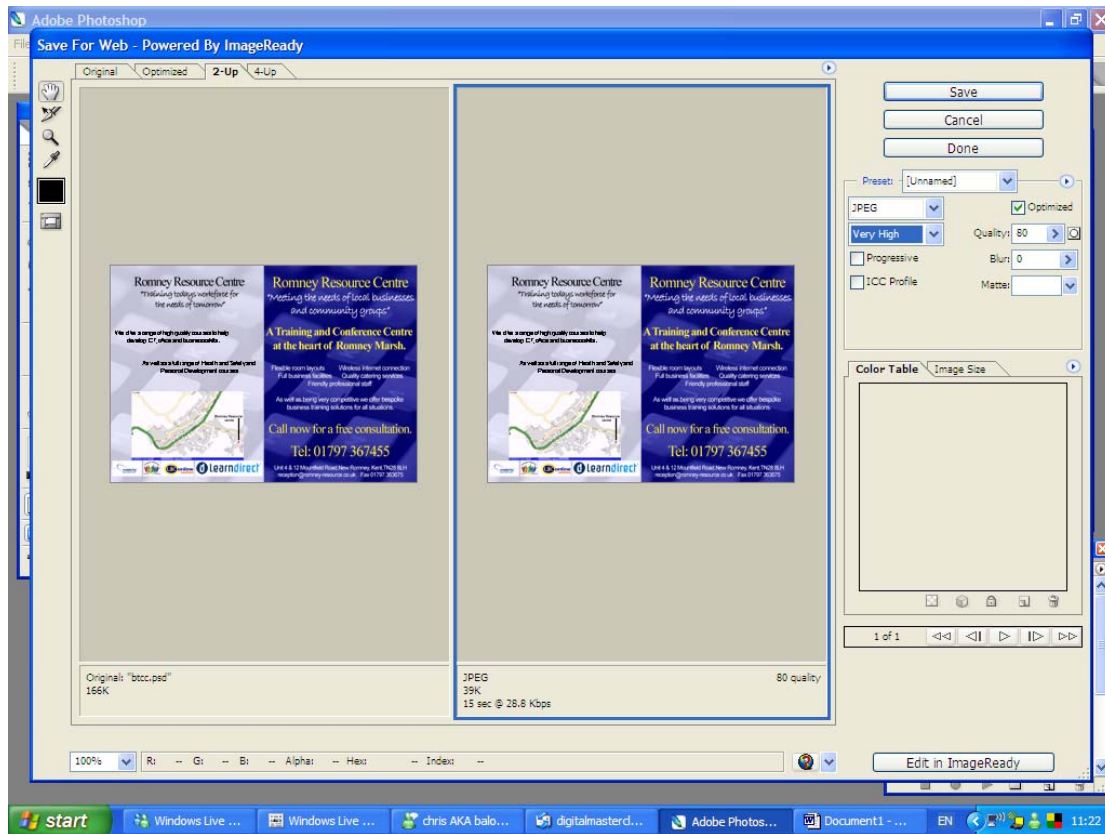
# Resizing your images within Photoshop



In Photoshop or Elements you need to have your image open. You then go to Image – Image Size. Within this window you can change the dimensions of your image as well as the resolution. For unit submissions we would like you to resize your images to 500 pixels at the longest length. You would then save the image through the save as option choosing a new name for the file, never save over the original image. Use a jpeg file format choosing 8 or above quality level.



Your size image can be reduced further by using the “Save For Web” option within Photoshop. Reducing the image size from 300k down to well under 100k. Though for your submissions I would still recommend you kept the quality level to high or very high this should keep your image to around 50 - 100k and still saving as a jpeg file.



Most other image manipulation software packages will have similar options though possibly in different locations.
